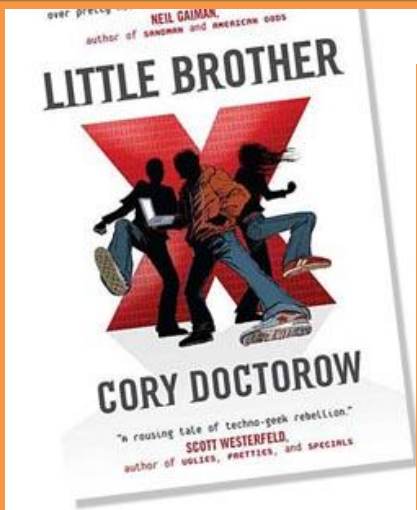
### **Textbooks in the Library**

### **CENSORSHIP CAUSES BLINDNESS**

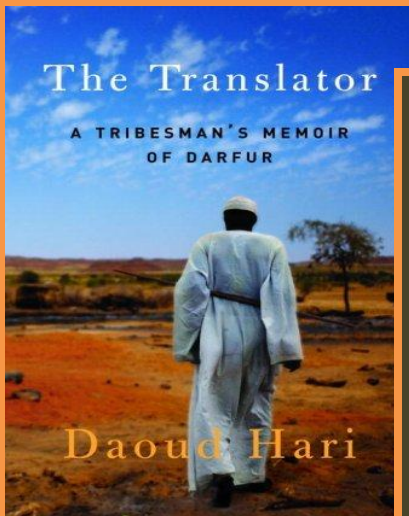

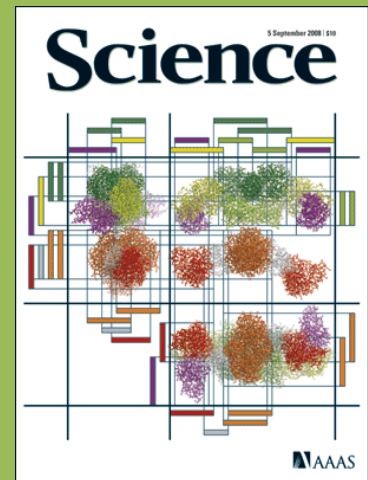
